

## Communiqué

### Temporary Facility for French Tourists to travel to Mauritius with Valid French Identity Card

French Tourists will be exceptionally allowed to travel to Mauritius as from **01 November 2017 until 15 March 2018** with a **valid** French Identity Card provided that:-

- (a) They should travel from an embarkation point in France to Mauritius directly or via Reunion Island;
- (b) They should meet the usual immigration requirements in terms of air tickets, sufficient financial means and confirmed accommodation arrangements;
- (c) They should on arrival produce their valid national identity cards in lieu of their passports to the Passport and Immigration Control Officers at the point of entry and will be issued with a “**Authorisation D’entrée**” where an immigration stamp will be affixed to show the duration of stay, and
- (d) They should present the “**Authorisation D’entrée**” to the Immigration Control Officers on their departure for control purpose.
